Limited Edition Print Selected For ArtWalk

Tony Schanuel's "Crystalline Garden" Chosen For Print

Saint Louis, MO – April 25 19, 2006 – Artwork created by Tony Schanuel, a photographer and digital artist, has been selected for the limited edition print that will be for sale at the St. Charles Spring ArtWalk, April 28-30, 2006. The picture, featuring brilliantly-colored tulips and shown below, will be printed on fine art archival paper and will be sold for \$35 at various venues at the ArtWalk. Only 100 prints will be produced and each will be signed and numbered.



“I work very intuitively,” Schanuel said, “and I happened to pick up that clutch of tulips that day and started playing around with it.” The selection committee chose Schanuel’s submission because it best represents the tone and quality of the upcoming ArtWalk. Schanuel’s art, which is inspired by molten glass and the glass blowing studios in Murano, Italy, can be seen in his studio at the Foundry Art Centre, 520 North Main Center, St. Charles.

The juried ArtWalk, which is free and open to the public, will showcase 50 professional regional artists who will exhibit their work in a dozen sites on Main Street in downtown St. Charles and in the Foundry Art Centre, 520 North Main Center. Art work will be offered for sale and the artists will be on-site to interact with the public and discuss their work. Hours for the ArtWalk are:
